Original Pair, Circa 1923, Columns Made by <b>George Kenning &amp; Son Ltd, London</b> - 2 Printed Globe Gores were used - The Celestial &amp; Terrestrial Miniature Clones made by <b>J. Smith &amp; Sold by C. Smith, 63, Charing Cross (founded in 1799) - Moved to 32, Fleet St. EC</b> - Smith's Celestial Cartouche marked <b>George Philip &amp; Son Ltd, 32 Fleet St. EC</b> - Smith's Terrestrial Cartouche marked <b>Showing the Latest Discoveries to the Present Text London, G. Philip &amp; Son Ltd, 32 Fleet St, EC</b>. The Columns are in a poor state of repair with missing sections to both columns, both loose &amp; leaning off centre. One half of the globe gores is missing &amp; the other is peeling back. As they are our original Columns we will keep both for historical purposes.</li> <li>2. In our unsuccessful search for a Vintage Pair of Columns matching our original ones, a new pair of SW &amp; JW Columns &amp; Column Rests were purchased from A. R. Fabb Ltd.</li> <li>3. After purchasing the new Wardens Columns, a London Masonic Centre contacted us to say they now have a pair available similar in every respect to our original ones, same Column Maker &amp; same Smiths Printed Globe Gores, but made in 1929. The Columns needed to be refurbished with missing sections to the Columns, but the Globes were in very good condition &amp; intact.
